Successful completion of the course will be a mandatory requirement for license as an Architect with the AANB. Although the course is mandatory for interns, it is available for all members.

We hope to launch Modules #2 and #3 in the next 12-24 months.



How do you access Module #1?




3. Sign into your member portal using your Email / Username and Password.
